Kunming University, established in May 2004, is a comprehensive full-time University approved by Ministry of Education of China. The University has a wide array of disciplines with 60 bachelor degree programs, 3 master degree programs and 7 provincial master degree construction programs.

The University is located in Kunming, a famous cultural city with picturesque scenery and pleasant mild weather all the year round. Primarily, the University focuses on cultivating students' application skills. In 2017, it was named “Yunnan Application Demonstration University”, and up to now it has obtained 203 national or provincial “Teaching Quality Engineering” construction projects. Thanks to the application-oriented education, the employment rate of graduates is among the highest in the province, and it has been awarded as the Highest Employment Rate University by the Provincial Ministry of Education.

The University never stops exploring and promoting international education cooperation. It has signed more than 127 cooperation agreements and memoranda with 72 universities and educational institutions in 20 countries and regions, and has established many cooperation platforms, for example, Netherlands BTEC Education and Training Center, Kunming University and Mandalay Chinese Education Center, ASEAN Business School, Irish Center, Yoga Center, China-Canada Preschool Education Center, Kunming University Bangkok Internship Base, Kunming University and Paris Fifth University Cooperative Research Center, China-Thailand Culinary Culture Research Centre and etc. Currently there are about 300 full-time international students.

Package A--Chinese Traditional Calligraphy and Painting

1.Introduction

This package combines the theoretical knowledge of Chinese art history and Chinese traditional art appreciation. Students will participate in series of lectures and activities, such as Chinese Calligraphy Sealing Art, Chinese Flower and Bird Painting, Chinese Landscape Painting, Chinese Figure Painting, Chinese Temple Cave Paintings and related academic hands-on experiences. This very dynamic integration of teaching and practice will lead to the enhancement of students' artistic creation skills and appreciation abilities of Chinese traditional calligraphy and painting art.

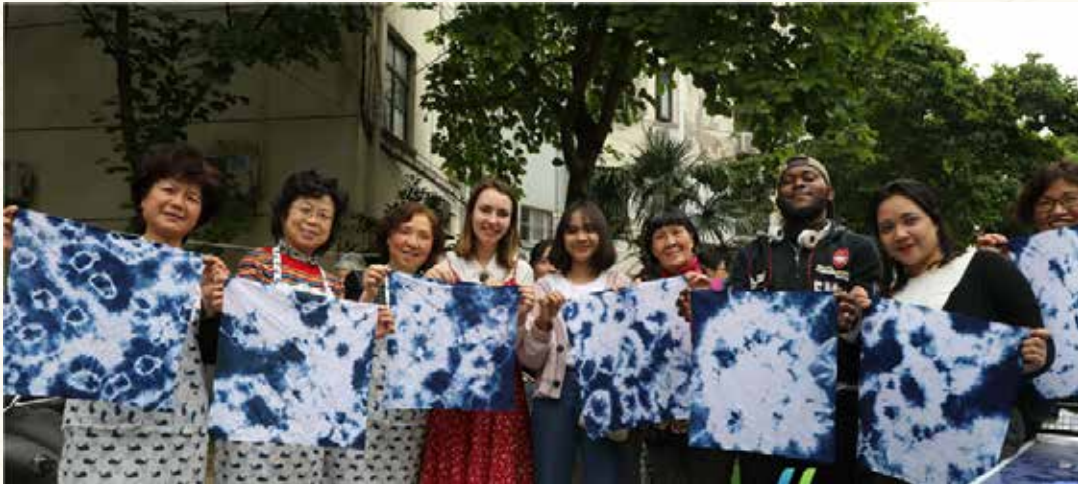

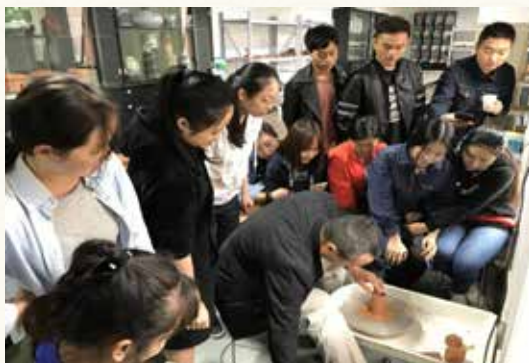

1. Introduction



Kunming is known as the world's spring city, and the flower industry center of China, South Asia and Southeast Asia. Kunming University has been awarded as the First Workshop of Famous Flower Arrangement Craftsmen, therefore it is also regarded as the cradle of Kunming's flower culture. It is in this University that the Chinese Flower Arrangement Art courses have been taught for

more than 20 years. So far, more than 1,000 outstanding flower arrangement artists have been trained by this University.

This package, by focusing on Chinese flower arrangement art, will improve the trainee's Chinese flower arrangement design ability, shape his individual style, and eventually enhance his aesthetic ability.
